

Drop-in Lunch Bunch

2024—2025 Registration

Registration for the 2024–25 school year begins on January 2nd. A registration form will be distributed in your child's bag in January and is due back by January 31st. If you need a form for a younger sibling, please let the ELC office know. You will receive verification of class placement in early February. To secure your child's placement, September's tuition and the \$75 registration fee is due by February 29, 2024. <u>This</u> <u>payment must be made by check. It will</u> not be automatically deducted with your <u>monthly tuition.</u> Registration for new families will begin in February.

SECURITY UPDATE

We wanted to provide everyone with an update on the ELC's security system. Over the last year, we have gone through the process of updating our current security system. The new system includes both internal and external cameras. All exterior doors are locked at all times and individuals need either an app or key card to gain access to the building. We also have direct contact with police if necessary with the push of a button.



*Sick children should stay home until they are feeling better. With the cold/flu season starting, we need to be mindful of the need to not send children to school until cold symptoms have subsided without the assistance of medicine and they are fever/symptom free for 24 hrs.

*Please be sure to notify the office if your child will be out along with the reason.

*Health records are required for every child. Nurse Thawley will let you know when your due date is approaching.

*To comply with licensing, we are required to have an annual physical, TB screen (dated within the last year) and lead screening completed at 12 months and 24 months, along with vaccination records.



Check the weather before school! We go outside on clear days, as long as the wind chill is above freezing. Send in hats, gloves, and winter coats each day to be sure your child is warm enough on the playground! Don't forget to label all items!
